- 7) Deaf and blind children experience joy through horses.
- 8) Vinceremos Therapeutic Riding Center in Loxahatchee, Florida, shows the work they do for people with learning disabilities.
- 9) An exploration of the connection between neonatal maladjustment syndrome in foals and autism in children.
- 10) Equine assisted therapy helps war veterans cope with Post Traumatic Stress Disorder.
- 11) Parents, volunteers, and kids share their experiences at Save The Horses in Cumming, Georgia.
- 12) An introduction of Horsehuggers, a partnership between merchants and equine therapy organizations.

Very unique pairings of well-known people are brought together through a mutual love of horses: Democrat and Republican, conservatives and liberals, cops and Black Lives Matter, Jew and Arab, young and old, gay and straight, etc.
- 7) Celebrities and everyday people of faith ride their horses in majestic settings.
